2018/19 SUMMER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Are you thinking about doing an honours year or interested in finding out more about what's involved in undertaking a research project? The ARC Centre of Excellence in Population Ageing Research Summer Scholarship program is designed to give students an opportunity to do precisely that. Successful applicants will join one of several research teams over a defined period during the summer break to undertake a specific project focused on population ageing.

Projects available

A full list of projects will be advertised in August each year.

Eligibility

Local and international students enrolled in the second or third year of a full-time program at an Australian or New Zealand university are eligible to apply.

Benefits and tenure

Successful applicants will receive a weekly stipend of \$625 (tax exempt) for the duration of the project which will be from 4 to 8 weeks* (to take place over the summer break of their university, generally between November and February).

*Please note students will not be required over any university Christmas shutdown.

Application procedure and deadline

Application forms will be available on the CEPAR website from early August and applications will close on Friday 28 September 2018.

Assessment

Applications will be assessed by CEPAR on the basis of academic merit, research potential and alignment with the required knowledge and skills as well as preferred attributes specified in the project description. It is expected that successful applicants will be notified in early November 2018.
