BURSARY APPLICATION GUIDELINES

The Emerging Researchers in Ageing (ERA) initiative, together with the ARC Centre for Excellence in Population Ageing Research (CEPAR) and the ERA 2019 conference sponsors, is pleased to offer a small number of bursaries to assist current students in ageing to attend and present at the ERA 2019 conference.

The level of bursary offered will partly reflect travel costs, with students from the host city offered less than those from elsewhere in the state, interstate, and overseas.

The outcome of bursary applications will be advised in mid-September. Successful applicants will be required to provide bank details and evidence of conference-related expenditure prior to bursary funds being reimbursed. Funds will then be transferred to a nominated bank account.

Please note the following conditions for application which apply to all bursaries:

Eligibility criteria

- Currently enrolled student conducting research in ageing at a University.
- An abstract to present a paper or poster at the ERA 2019 conference is accepted.
- The research you are undertaking is expected to benefit the field of ageing.
- Bursaries are available to individuals who are either not in receipt of any other financial assistance or as a 'top-up' for those receiving partial financial assistance to attend the ERA 2019 conference.
- All presenters must be registered for ERA 2019 by Friday 27 September. Presenters not registered by this date will forfeit their abstract acceptance and any awarded bursary.

Bursary application

- Bursary applications must be submitted **by Sunday 8 September 2019**.
- Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.
- Notification of the outcome of your application will be emailed to you approximately one week after the application deadline.
